Discussion Guide #2: Delving Deeper Into Themes

Empathy

- 1. Define what empathy means. What does it mean to have empathy?
- 2. What is the difference between empathy and sympathy?
- 3. What are ways you show others you care for them?
- 4. Why does Tako become worried for Allie?
- 5. How does Tako feel when he finds Allie's room in the attic? What does he learn about her? Why does he then want to find her?
- 6. The first problem in the book is that there is a thief in the house. What caused that problem?
- 7. What is a first impression? Are first impressions always true?
- 8. Did you ever think something about someone that turned out not to be true?
- 9. After Allie is made to leave the Lee house, Ricky tells Tako to "forget about her". But he couldn't forget about her. Why not?
- 10. Why is Tako still mad at Allie after she is made to leave the house?
- 11. Describe Tako and Ricky's friendship. Describe Tako and Allie's friendship. What's the difference?
- 12. When Ricky and his friends find Tako in the hole, they begin laughing. Why?
- 13. If you found a thief in your house, what would you do?
- 14. What is an enemy? Are Tako and Allie enemies?
- 15. Why did Allie steal?
- 16. How do Tako's feelings toward Allie change from the beginning of the story to the end?
- 17. How does each character in the story feel about Allie? How do their feelings change from the beginning fo the story to the end?

Empathy

- 18. What does Allie think of Tako? Do her feelings toward him change from the beginning of the story to the end?
- 19. What could Allie have done differently to stay in the Lee home?
- 20. On one night in the story, Tako sleeps well; on another he does not sleep well. Why? Do you ever have trouble falling asleep?
- 21. Have you ever had anything stolen from you? If so, how did it make you feel?
- 22. Was Allie afraid of Tako? Was Tako afraid of Allie?

Good & Bad Behavior

- 1. After reading the story, would you say that Allie is a good cat or a bad cat? What are some of her actions that would be considered "good" or "bad"?
- 2. Why did Allie steal Mia and Lia's things?
- 3. What is a villain? Is there a villain in this story?
- 4. Is Allie a bad cat?
- 5. If Allie could speak, what would she say about her behavior?
- 6. How does Allie change by the end of the story?
- 7. Was Tako good or bad to bark at Grandpa Lee? Why was Grandpa Lee surprised?

Heroism / Fear

- 1. Tako risked his safety to save Allie. Why did he do that? Is he a hero? What kinds of actions are heroic?
- 2. Why does Tako bark at Grandpa Lee?
- 3. Mimi Lee says Tako is a "protector dog". Have you ever stood up for someone else?
- 4. Was Allie afraid of the river rats? Have you ever been afraid of something?
- 5. Are the rats dangerous? What are dangerous things in your life?
- 6. When Tako first meets the river rats he runs away from them. Can you still be a hero even if you run away?

- 10. What is Tako's ultimate goal in the story? What is Allie's ultimate goal? What is the Lee family's ultimate goal? How do these goals intersect or create conflict?
